13	Bronze – 100 points minimum
	Each area submits 5 applications by December 15 =
	24 areas x 5 applications = 120 submitted applications and 120
	selected as Bronze Competitive Achievement.
	Receive 33.3% Scholarship to Teen Conference
14	Silver – 150 points minimum
	Each area submits 5 applications by December 15 =
	24 areas x 5 applications = 120 applications submitted and 70
	selected at Silver. Receive 66.6% Scholarship to Teen Conference
15	Gold – 200 points minimum
	Each area submits 4 applications by December 15 =
	24 areas x 4 applications = 96 submitted and 40 selected as Gold.
	Receive 100%Scholarship to Teen Conference, \$800 Scholarship to Congress
16	Emerald – must have achieved prior achievement of Gold and not aged out of Kentucky 4-H
	Youth will submit an updated application, video, and two
	recommendation letters by December 15. Twenty will be selected to
	interview at Teen Conference. Interview candidates must being a
	cover letter and resume to interviews.
