

# <u>Loaded Beef Stroganof</u>



- (choose whole-wheat if available) 1 pound lean ground beef 12 ounces egg noodles
- 1 large onion, chopped
- 2 tablespoons garlic powder
- 8 ounces sliced white mushrooms 1/4 cup all-purpose flour
  - 32 ounces (or 4 cups) low-
    - 1 can (14.5 ounces) no-saltsodium beef broth
- added sliced carrots, drained 1 can (14.5 ounces) no-saltadded peas, drained
- 11/2 cups plain nonfat Greek
  - yogurt or light sour cream 11/2 teaspoons salt
- Parmesan cheese (optional) 1 teaspoon black pepper
- water and soap, scrubbing Wash hands with warm for at least 20 seconds.
- Wash fresh produce under cool running water. Cut to prepare for the recipe. ai
- On the stove, preheat a large pot preparing the other steps. Drain. Cook egg noodles according to package directions while 4. ŝ
