Return before Oct. 31st, No Special 4-H Bucks for Enrollment after Oct. 31st




Allen County 4-H loves our Cloverbuds!!!

In order to create the best experience for our littles, 4-H ages 5-8, we would like to share some changes to our Cloverbud Policy with our 4-H Families:

Allen County 4-H Council would like to remind all 4-H Families that ALL Cloverbud youth, between 4-H Ages 5-8, must be chaperoned by their own parent/adult at ALL 4-H activities including, Club Meetings, Workshops, Events, etc.

In order for Allen County 4-H to provide the best individualized learning experiences for our Cloverbud and older 4-H youth, starting Sept. 2024 Cloverbuds are limited to age appropriate clubs and workshops. This includes:

- Cloverbud Club
- Helping Hands Community Club
- Livestock Club (if showing Livestock)
- Poultry Club (if showing Poultry)







What are 4-H Bucks???

4-H bucks are 4-H certificates that allow 4-Her's to pay for 4-H activities, registration fees, camps, conferences and more, without being out of pocket for the cash!
Youth may receive 4-H bucks by turning in 4-H enrollment forms, participating in fundraisers & attending various 4-H events.

- 1 medium onion, diced
 - 1 teaspoon salt
- 11/2 teaspoons dried oregano
- 3/4 teaspoon black pepper
- 4 cloves garlic, minced, or
- 2 pounds sweet potatoes, peeled 1/2 teaspoon garlic powder
 - chicken breasts, fat trimmed 2 pounds boneless, skinless and diced (1-inch cubes)
- 4 ounces baby spinach (about 4 cups) and diced (1-inch cubes)
