Must complete 6 hours of training under the supervision of a certified livestock volunteer.		
Giving a 3-5-minute presentation at KY State Fair on the required topic: <u>Junior (Born 2013– 2009); Discuss the history of the country ham.</u> Country ham is considered a Southeastern food, but that was not always the case. Before mechanical refrigeration, salting food was a common preservation method. Discuss the history of the country ham and how it became part of Kentucky's food heritage.		
Senior (Born 2004 – 2008); Discuss the pests that infest country hams and how to control them. Country hams are susceptible to various pests; identify those pests and discuss the various ways the pests can be controlled and/or eliminated.		
Please note – ALL SENIOR'S PRESENTATIONS MUST BE AT LEAST 2 MINUTES LONG OR THEY WILL BE DIS-QUALIFIED AND HAMS FORFIETED.

- 1 medium onion, chopped
- 1 medium carrot, chopped
- 3 tablespoons minced garlic
- 1 teaspoon Italian seasoning 1 teaspoon dried oregano
- 2 (15-ounce) cans no-saltadded tomato sauce
- 1 (8-ounce) package fresh
