CHECK-IN – MONDAY, JULY 1st

- Arrive Time Option #1 – Arrive at 7:00 AM :

Complete Head Check Morning-Of Departure Onsite

- Arrive Time Option # 2 – Arrive at 7:30 AM :

Completed Head Check by Professional in Advance

- ALL Campers should arrive no later than 7:30 AM to the Allen County Extension Office Parking Lot and report to the registration tables
- At registration tables: Camper Parents will check-in, pick up nametag & luggage tags, drop off medications
- Luggage will be color coded by gender using colored luggage tags. Boys luggage is to be loaded first in the trailer. Female luggage loaded on bus.



DEPARTURE – MONDAY, JULY 1st

- Campers may begin loading bus in Parking Lot at 7:30 AM
- Bus will depart at 8:00 AM SHARP!!!
- Be sure to use the restrooms before departing; camp is a 2-hour drive
- Campers may carry on a pillow, snack and bottled drinks with caps.
- We will stop halfway for bathroom stop at Beaver Dam Gas Station. Bring snack money.
- Campers will be pre-assigned a bus by their age. See Camp Bus Roster for info.



HEALTHY CAMPERS

- The University of KY 4-H Camping Program has a NO NIT POLICY:
 - “A child will not be permitted to attend camp if determined the child has head lice or nits on the scalp.”

A head-lice check must take place within 72 hours preceding boarding the bus for camp.

Earliest time: Friday 6/28th @ 8 AM

1. You may have a HEAD-LICE CHECK done on-your-own by a licensed medical professional and they must sign off on the Head Lice Form OR
 2. We will have a HEAD-LICE CHECK THREE days before camp @ the Extension Office by licensed medical personnel.
 3. We will have a HEAD-LICE CHECK the DAY-OF we leave for camp @ the Extension Office by licensed medical personnel.
- If Head Lice is found....
the camper will not be permitted to attend camp.

LICE CHECKS PROVIDED EITHER:

- **FRIDAY 6/28 @ 3-6 PM OR**
- **MONDAY 7/1 AT 7:00 AM BEFORE DEPARTURE!!!**



MEDICATIONS



If your camper has medication....

- All medication must be:
 - Placed in a clear Ziploc Bag label with:
 - Camper Name
 - County
 - Cabin Number
 - Left in original container
 - Medication form enclosed
 - Portrait Photo of Child close-up
 - Turn in meds at registration tables
- All meds are turned into the health care provider (hcp) upon arrival and only inhalers and epi pens may be kept with the camper with doctor's note and proper method of carrying it (please notify us).
- Do not pack additional tylenol, aspirin, etc. HCP will have on hand & give as per the direction of parents as indicated on the med form.



4-H CAMP ARRIVAL

- We plan to arrive at CAMP by 10:30 AM.
- Campers will unload buses and meet as a county in Singing Area while cabin leaders inspect the cabins. Expect 15-30 min wait.
- Girls luggage unloaded first from bus. Must be able to carry luggage in one load roughly 200 yards.
- Boys will have luggage dropped at cabins. Must carry own luggage.
- Campers will move into cabins, make beds & unpack.
- Cabins will have 2 hours for move-in and settling into camp. Campers welcome to play games in Singing Area.
- Allen County will eat Lunch at 12:30 PM.

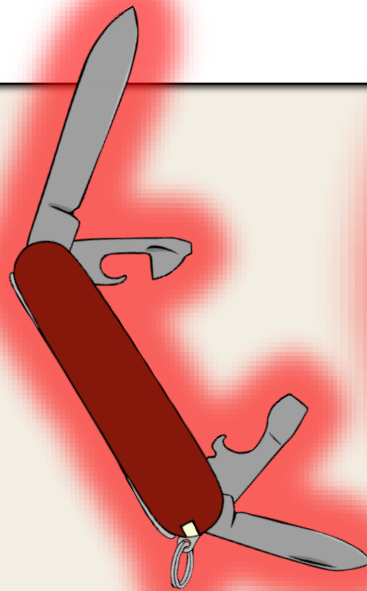

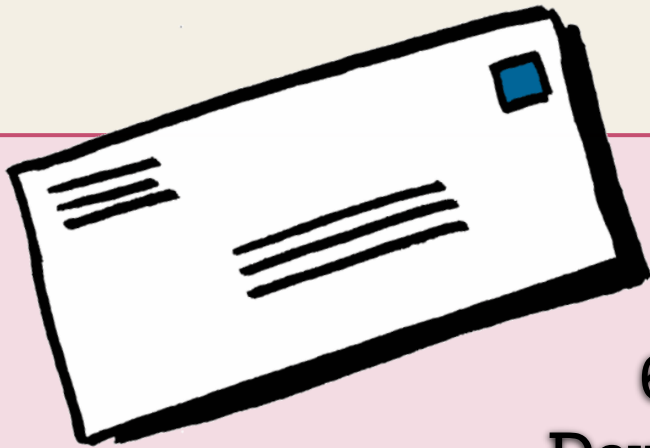
CAMP CLASS PREFERENCES



Camp Class List & Description

- = **Agriculture**—Youth will learn about different ag products, work in the community garden, and fun activities
- = **Archery**—Youth will learn the safety of using a bow & arrow and how to shoot an arrow at a target
- = **Canoeing**—Youth will learn water safety and how to operate a canoe with a partner
- = **Cooking**—Youth will participate in indoor cooking, learn to cook on a grill, and make some sweet treats. In this class we will be cooking a variety of recipes from scratch and then the best part, afterwards we get to EAT those!
- = **Crafts**—In craft we will be making learning to make survival bracelets, water-color painting with clouds, beaded animal key chains
- = **Disc Golf**—Disc Golf—Learn how to play a freebie disc golf course
- = **Flag Sports**—Freeze Flag, Flag Football, Capture the Flag, and Smear the Flag
- = **Fishing**—Learn to bait, cast, & catch
- = **Low Ropes**—Youth will do team building activities and group problem solving with heights ranging from on the ground to up to 4 feet off the ground.
- = **Messy Science**—Join us for three days of fun, messy science projects. If you enjoy science and like to have fun, then this is the class for you! We will be making: Crystal Stars, Bouncy Balls, Smelly Clay, Snow Slime and more!
- = **Nature**—Youth will learn about different types of wildlife at camp, plus take nature walk looking for different animals
- = **Nature Crafts**—Youth will be creating crafts found in nature, they will create nature weaving, create dandelion crowns, and do a little journaling
- = **Relaxation Station**—Need to get away from the heat and noise of the day, we will do a little hammocking, coloring, board games, and possible read books
- = **Recreation**—Fun outdoor activities including low ropes course and more
- = **Rifle**—Youth will learn the safety of using a gun and how to fire it at a target
- = **Survival Skills**—Youth will learn basic survival skills including topics such as making fire, water purification, making shelter, orienteering, & signaling.
- = **Swimming**—Youth learn water safety, little swimming, and water games. This will not teach them how to swim.
- = **Zip Line**—Youth will learn team building skills, they may get a chance to go down a zip line and use the climbing wall

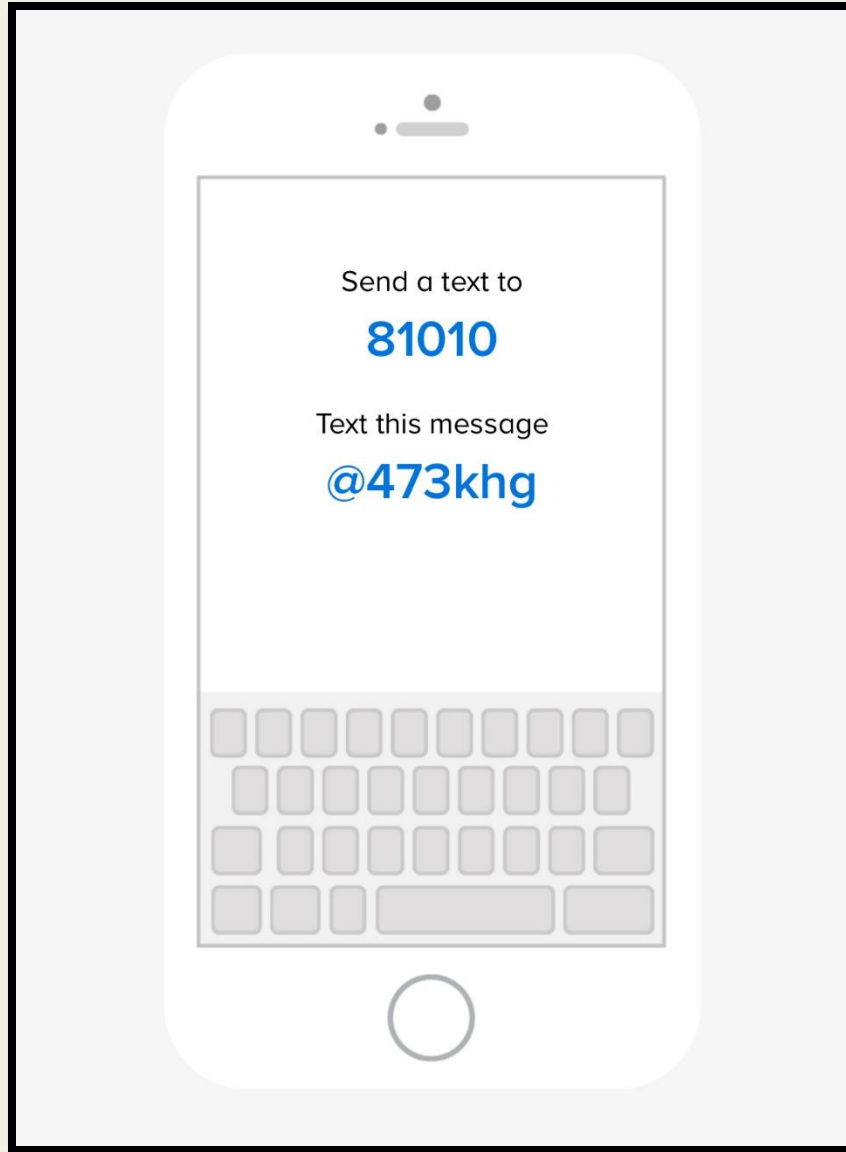

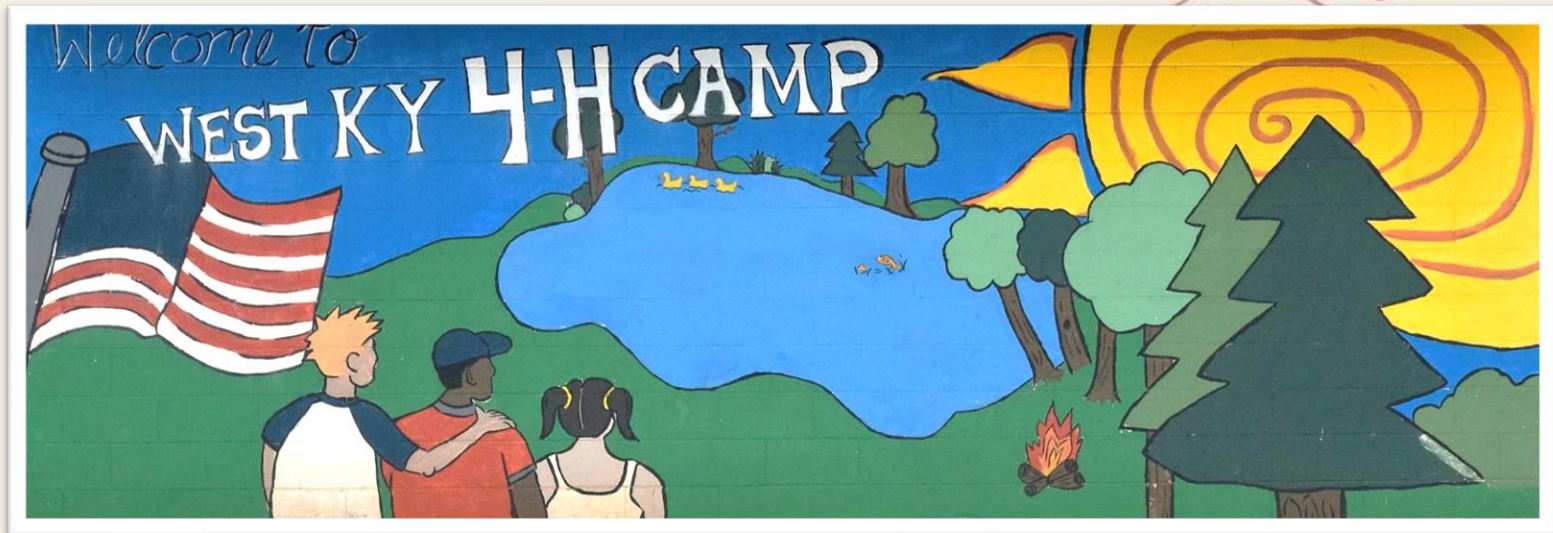
